



## **WSP Statement Regarding Logansport Mayor Chris Martin's Announced Position on the Proposed WSP Facility**

**CASS COUNTY, IN – April 14, 2020 – Waelz Sustainable Products (“WSP”) today issued the following statement in response to Logansport Mayor Chris Martin’s announcement that he would oppose the proposed Cass County zinc processing facility:**

“Mayor Martin decided to oppose the WSP facility – after saying on a number of occasions that he wouldn’t take a position given the proposal falls outside of his jurisdiction – without any engagement with our company. He did not ask us to meet, he didn’t ask us any questions and he did not request any information. The WSP team would be happy to meet with the mayor at his convenience to share the facts about our proposal and address his questions to ensure he has all the relevant information to take a position.

“WSP also stands ready to participate in-person at relevant public forums in Cass County as allowed during the COVID-19 restrictions. We are currently working with Cass County officials to schedule an in-person meeting, targeting late-May. In addition, we are responding to questions from individual citizens as they reach out to the company, and are looking at other means to share information and engage with the community during the current travel and meeting restrictions. We want Cass County residents to have the facts and data about our project so they can make informed decisions for themselves.”
